

Cookie and Web Analytics Notice

With this Cookie Notice we would like to inform you about how we at Trans Adriatic Pipeline AG (hereinafter "TAP" or "we" or "us") use cookies on our Website www.tap-ag.com (hereinafter "Website").

We collect non-personal data in connection with the use of our Website for the purposes of data security and on-going optimisation of usability. This automatically collected data is not combined with other data sources.

1. Cookies

We use so-called cookies on the browser side. Cookies do no harm to your computer, they are small files with configuration settings that help us make our Website more user-friendly, effective and secure. Cookies are also used to implement certain user functions.

Our Website uses "session cookies", which are automatically deleted when the browser is closed, as well as "persistent cookies", which remain on your end device until they expire or are manually deleted by you. The latter are "Third Party Cookies" that enable us to recognize your browser on your next visit. Details on Third Party Cookies, i.e. cookies from third party providers such as Google Inc. can be found in their respective privacy policy.

You can choose your browser or the privacy settings of your devices so that you are informed about the setting of cookies and only allow cookies in individual cases. You can also exclude the acceptance of cookies for certain cases or generally and activate the automatic deletion of cookies when closing the browser. However, if cookies are deactivated, it is possible that not all functions of our Website can be used in full.

2. Web Analysis

In order to continuously optimize the usability and functions of our Website, we use web analysis tools and social plug-ins from Google Analytics as described below. Only non-personal data is used for this purpose.

Google Analytics: Google Analytics of Google Inc, 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA uses so-called "cookies", text files which are stored on your computer and which enable an analysis of your navigation behaviour in our Website. The information collected by the cookie about your user behaviour is usually transferred to a Google server in the USA and stored there. However, since IP anonymization is activated on this website, Google reduces your IP address in Member States of the European Union or in other countries party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area beforehand. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be transmitted to a Google server in the USA and shortened there. Google will use this information to evaluate your use of the Website on our behalf, to compile reports for us on these activities and to provide us with further services associated with the use of the Website and the Internet. The (full or masked) IP address transmitted by your browser in the context of Google Analytics is not merged with other Google data.

You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of our Website. You can also prevent Google from collecting the data generated by the cookie and relating to your use of a Website and from processing this data by Google by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available under the following link (<http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout?hl=en>). 3. Cookies currently used by our Website

The following cookies are currently used on our Website:

Necessary cookies: necessary cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies. Our website uses the necessary cookies JSESSIONID and PHPSESSID.

Functional cookies: these are statistics cookies that help the website owners understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously. Our website uses the statistics cookies “_ga”, “_gat”, “_gid” and “collect”.

4. Consent to the use of cookies

By using our Website, you consent to the processing of your data in the manner and for the purposes set out above.
